

# SUPERIOR VENDING DART LEAGUES

**FORMAT:** Superior Vending offers both handicapped and unhandicapped leagues. Unless otherwise noted, all leagues are combo leagues playing 12-game matches consisting of 6 games of 501 and 6 games of cricket.

**SEASONS:** We offer three seasons of play: Fall (starting soon after Labor Day and running through mid to late December), Winter (starting in mid to late January or early February and running through early May) and Spring/Summer (starting after Memorial Day and ending before Labor Day). Note that some leagues are Fall/Winter leagues that span both the Fall and Winter seasons.

**INCLEMENT WEATHER:** Superior Vending will NEVER cancel matches due to bad weather. Matches missed due to weather will not be considered forfeits unless a team no call/no shows.

**FEES/PAYOUT:** Players pay for their games plus a weekly league fee, plus NDA sanction fee. Cost is variable depending on the league format, but is generally between \$7 and \$9 per player per week. Unless otherwise noted, payout is generally 50 cents per team member per win, so a doubles team would receive \$1 per win, a trips team would get \$1.50 per win, a four-person team \$2 per win.

**FORFEITS:** League payouts are based on the assumption that every team in the league will play every scheduled match. If your team forfeits a match, you will go 0-12 that week and your opponent will be awarded the highest win total based on the following: A) Wins equivalent to their overall team winning percentage; B) Wins in other matchup(s) with forfeiting opponent; C) a 7-5 win. Forfeiting team will be responsible for paying league fees for both teams. In the case of a double forfeit, each team will be given a 7-5 loss that week and each team will have its league fees for the unplayed match deducted from their payout. Every effort to make up matches should be made by both teams.

**SANDBAGGING:** If you think a team is sandbagging, please notify the league director, and please include as much detail as possible. Also please avoid name-calling, threats or arguing with the person/team you think is sandbagging.

**HANDICAPS:** In handicapped leagues, all players will start the season with a handicap, based on previous league stats or known ability. When new players play, teams should enter the new players' MPR and PPD at the board before the start of their match. (It is important to plug in a player's MPR and PPD regardless of their skill level ... not entering stats for a lower level player will result in them being given starting MPR and PPDs equal to the top player in the match, and not entering stats for a new high-level player can put existing league players at a big disadvantage.)

**TOURNAMENTS:** Superior Vending leagues qualifies you for MOMA (Minnesota State), WAMO (Wisconsin State), MSPDA (Metro State Players Dart Association), Superior Regionals and Superior Year-End, as well as NDA. Not all leagues qualify you for all tournaments, so please verify when signing up that your league counts toward the tournament(s) you want to play.
